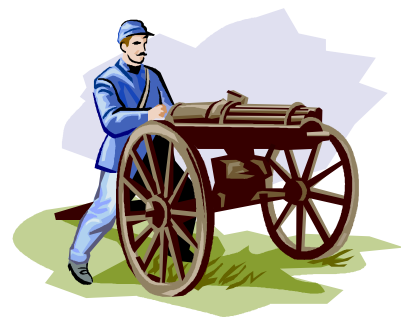
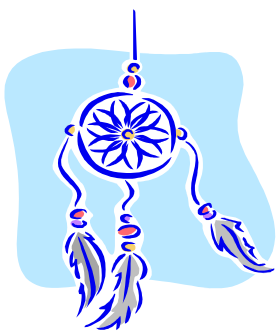


COMPEER ATLANTA visits Native Lands: Indians & Georgia at the Atlanta History Center
